


Macro Cell Tower Infrastructure in the City of High Point


















Macro Cell Base Station Infrastructure in the City of High Point





# Small Cell Wireless Facilities in City Non-Concealed

- Antenna mounted to the top of the pole with equipment at attached at lower elevation on the pole
- Antenna no more than three cubic feet
- All other equipment no more than 28 cubic feet in volume



# Substantive Changes Proposed to Ordinance

- Definitions to align with State Statutes
  - Minimum requirements for collocations
- No more SUP process, and what other changes might have been made to allow that to happen (allowance of concealed towers, etc.)
- Allowed in all rights-of-way and all zoning districts subject to design standards and height limitations
- Undergrounding standards for small wireless facilities
