 - Legal Review









Ensure Sign Ordinance is Constitutionally Sound



Content Neutrality

Legibility determines effect on some signs in buildings

Non-Commercial (election-related, opinion, religious) speech protected

No reference to "on-premise" and "off-premise"

Weekend directional signs allowed for all uses

Future amendments

Administration and Enforcement

Must be fair and equal
Enforcement should be proactive to ensure equal treatment
