**PURPOSE:** To highlight the positive effect that proactive police work combined with inter-agency cooperation and NIBIN (National Integrated Ballistics Information Network) has on addressing violent crime. Focus will be specifically on recent gun crimes and the success of using this network to make arrests and bring charges against individuals.

**BACKGROUND:** The High Point Police Department in cooperation with City Council has taken steps since 2018 to invest in technology and training to track firearms and spent shell casings. The High Point Police Department recognized a distinct increase in violent gun crime through proactive police work, data analysis, and technology advancements that helped jumpstart this effort. While not fully operational, the initial steps, training and investment in NIBIN has helped solve numerous crimes and has provided investigative leads on countless others.
